Orphan Grain Train

The Monthly Mission and Ministry for March is the Orphan Grain Train. The Orphan Grain Train is a recognized service organization of the LCMS. This means the Orphan Grain Train works primarily with congregations, ministries, and auxiliaries of the LCMS here in America and around the world wherever possible. Grain Train volunteers gather donations of clothing, medical supplies, food, Christian literature, and other aid to meet real needs. Contributors donate money to ship the precious cargoes of hope where most needed. (Eleven dollars sponsors the shipment of one box of aid!) Volunteers at the other end of the journey place these gifts of love into the hands of needy people. We believe that through Christ there is great hope embodied in the efforts of Orphan Grain Train. More than 3,728 semi-trailer truckloads of food, clothing, medical supplies, and religious materials have been sent to 69 countries and several disaster areas in the U.S. since 1992. All of this is done by volunteers and individual contributors. In loving response to Christ, the Servant, the Orphan Grain Train movement encourages and enables God's people to share personal and material resources in bringing Christ's name and character to needy people both far and near. Sometimes that character expresses itself as a word well spoken, sometimes as a bandage well applied, and sometimes as a child well fed. The Orphan Grain Train movement is a loving response to Jesus Christ's example as a servant and His love for us.
