## Orphan Grain Train Christmas Boxes

### Due Date Reminder: October 27th

With the approval of the Board of Elders, Peace Lutheran Church is participating in the Orphan Grain Train Christmas Box project. Many of you may have contributed to this project in the past. To others, this may be new. A list of items, age and gender appropriate, are placed in special boxes with specific instructions. These Christmas gift boxes will be sent internationally to recipients who will deliver them to children that may not receive any other Christmas package. In order for these boxes to be shipped, the Christmas Gift Box Instructions must be followed. Although variations are tempting, please do not do this. It could result in all of the packages being confiscated and no child receiving any gift. Why are we telling you about this now when the due date is October 27th? We wanted to give you plenty of time to shop for these items and watch for sales. If you want to participate, the boxes with specific instructions are on the counter in the Narthex near the mailboxes. If you want to do this with a partner, that is great.
